SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, next item.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment is from Senator Haberman. This is AM0897, it appears on page 1377.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Haberman withdraws that amendment. Next item.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment is from Senator Kristensen. This is AM1034.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Kristensen.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members. Just, for the Clerk, it's AM1034? And I have to apologize to the body, because these amendments didn't get printed, and though they were passed out this morning, we tried to get them printed, and for one reason or another that didn't get done. And so I beg your indulgence to do it. I have two amendments. The first one is AM1034, and it's underneath it has in parenthesis, number one. It is a ten-page amendment, but primarily the meat of the amendment is in the first three pages. This is a cleanup amendment that I would propose to do on Select File for a variety of reasons. If you look at LB 732, it's 181 pages. We made a lot of changes between Supreme Court and appellate court. Through making all those changes, some of them through the aid of a computer in changing the various things, we still had to go through by hand, and there were some changes we just plain didn't catch. I've been through the bill twice myself, we've had clerks and other people go through there trying to catch various things that needed to be amended, in other words powers that we were going to give to the appellate court you still want to keep for the Supreme Court, you want to include just some internal consistencies. And, quite frankly, with a bill that size it was unmanageable. I think we've been through it enough times between now and the first of January that we've caught those. There are some things on the first page that are primarily gender changes, to make sure that hopefully we're
