SPEAKER BAACK PRESIDING

SPEAKER BAACK: Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. With us this morning for the prayer we have Pastor Fred Wolfe from Friedens Lutheran here in Lincoln. Pastor Wolfe.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you. We will now proceed to Item 5 on the agenda, the confirmation report from the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee with Senator Conway.

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members. Last week the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee held a confirmation hearing for Gwendolyn Combs to be identified as the Director of the State Department of Personnel. It was a most enlightening opportunity to visit with Gwendolyn Combs who appears to be extremely well qualified and very energetic and excited about taking the position. And following that confirmation, the Government Committee voted unanimously to advance Gwendolyn Combs' name to the entire body for their vote with respect to confirming her for that position. So with that, Mr. Speaker, I offer Gwendolyn Combs to the body for
