SPEAKER BAACK: Is there any discussion of the confirmation report as presented by Senator Conway? Seeing none, we will proceed to vote on the confirmation report. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the confirmation report. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Government Committee confirmation report.

SPEAKER BAACK: The confirmation report is adopted. We are now ready for Item 6 on the agenda which is Final Reading so I would remind my colleagues that we will not start Final Reading until you are in your seats, so please take your seats so we may start Final Reading. Before we do start Final Reading, I would like to introduce some visitors in the Legislature today. First of all, I'd like to introduce the doctor of the day. We have Nancy Tabor of Lincoln and she is here from Senator Crosby's district so, Nancy, would you please stand and be welcomed by the Legislature. And also we have a guest of Senator Nelson. We have Mrs. Van Wren of Grand Island and she is under the south balcony. Would you please stand and be welcomed by the Legislature. Thank you for being with us. Please take your seats, colleagues, so we can start on Final Reading. Proceed with LB 44, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read LB 44 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 44 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 1456-57 of the Legislative Journal.) 39 ayes, 0 nays, 10 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 44 passes. We go to LB 160.

CLERK: (Read LB 160 on Final Reading.)
