

Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 1457-58 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 45 ayes, 0 nays, 4 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 160 passes. Before we proceed to the next bill I would like to introduce some guests of the Legislature. They are guests of Senator Nelson in the south balcony. They are 56 fourth graders and their teachers from the Engleman School in Grand Island. Would you folks please stand and be welcomed by the Legislature. Thank you for being with us. I might also tell you that there are going to be some tornado drills this morning in the Capitol. They are going to be blowing the whistles and stuff for the severe weather coming up in the future but we do not have to evacuate or anything. SPEAKER BAACK: LB 162 with the emergency clause attached passes. LB 190.

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 190 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.
