

SENATOR WARNER: Senator Beutler, followed by Senator Robinson.
Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Call the question.

SENATOR WARNER: Senator Beutler has called the question. I see five hands, see five hands. Those in favor of ceasing debate vote aye, opposed vote nay. Clerk, record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to cease debate.

SENATOR WARNER: The motion is carried. Debate is ceased.
Senator Robinson, do you wish to close?

SENATOR ROBINSON: Mr. Speaker, members of the committee, I'd just like to discuss two points. Senator Haberman said we set a precedent at 50 years of age. Well, members of the body, we're going to set another one if we go with his bill. We're going to set one even if you go with mine, but there is a lot of difference. We will set a precedent between the ages of 30 and 50 but with my amendment you go once. With his you can go five times. The other one is I've been informed that there is an 800 number that you can call Hartford and check on your...you can check on the status of your different funds. So I think with those two I would like to urge you to bring the bill back to Select File. Thank you.

SENATOR WARNER: Motion is the return of LB 254 to Select File for a specific amendment. Those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Robinson.

SENATOR ROBINSON: (Mike not activated immediately)...present, Mr. Speaker. Check in and then have a roll call vote, please.

SENATOR WARNER: The request is for check in. We are on Final Reading. You should be in your chairs, check in and a roll call vote, motion to return the bill to Select File. Check in. Senator Robinson.

SENATOR ROBINSON: I'll accept call in votes if everyone didn't get back. They should be back, but...
