Thank you. I would like to give Senator Smith the rest of my time, please.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Smith, you have one minute.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. Speaker, I will talk really fast. I did get grabbed when I went out there. And I found out some information, that is that a college hour is equal to 15 class hours, so it isn't as bad as it sounds, by far. And I asked the question about are these courses offered across the state? Will they be obtainable by anyone in Nebraska? And they said, yes, they're going to be offered in all the technical community colleges, even in some of the communities themselves and they're gearing up for them right now in the colleges and, you know, the university system and so on. They did...they said that they absolutely are not asking any more than what the feds are requiring and, in fact, they're stretching it to try to do the least they can do because of what the feds are requiring. And so I am feeling satisfied right now that they're doing everything they can to just do what they have to do and it will be available. They can go back and pick up any training that they have had since 1976. So the hours that they have already accumulated can apply, so it may not be as bad as we originally thought it might have looked.
