

SENATOR WESELY: Yes, Mr. Speaker, members, I only want to point out, I haven't had a chance to talk with Senator Beutler about this but I did talk to representatives on behalf of the bill. If you note, there are three categories of appraisers, registered, licensed and then general certified appraisers. Under our health licensure laws, we have set up similar categories. We have set up for the first level of licensure in health profession register, that is everybody can get registered and we know who they are but we don't necessarily have very restrictive situations applying to them. Then we have certified as a second level; certified is those people choosing to achieve the recognition of being certified but it isn't a requirement, a mandate. And the highest level we consider to be licensed individuals. These are the top level. And I looked at this and I could see that the top level, under this provision, is not the licensed appraiser but the general certified appraiser. And it would be nice if we could start getting some consistency so terminology would mean something similar in various licensure respects and we've tried to take that to other areas. But, as I understand it, from what I've been told, we cannot amend those terms and make consistent with our other statutes the terminology used so I won't make any proposals. But I merely call it to your attention and for the information on the floor debate that this is different terminology than we use typically in other licensure areas in terms of the level and the term associated with it. But, evidently, because of the federal statutes involved, we have no option but to accept these terms and the categories they apply to. So I'm merely calling that to the attention of the body.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Wesely. Is there further discussion on the bill? Seeing none, Senator Beutler, do you wish to close?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, I would simply encourage the body again to advance the bill. I think we have had a pretty thorough discussion on it. And I would also genuinely invite you to take a close at it and to suggest for me, before General File, amendments if you should have any. Maybe I take a different attitude about amendments than some other people do. I really think that we're all here together to get the best products we can from 49 minds and I feel quite comfortable getting suggestions from other people and building things into my bills that make them better and make me look better in the
