LB 333

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Schimek's amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Schimek's amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill? Oh, we need a motion to readvance. Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Yeah, Mr. Speaker, I move that we readvance LB 333 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to advance LB 333. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Nelson would move to return the bill for a specific amendment. (Nelson amendment appears on page 1490 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Nelson.

SENATOR NELSON: Mr. Speaker, I would also move to return the bill for this amendment. As I mentioned just a few minutes ago, in Senator Schimek's, on line 15, after it says "such plates may be used solely for the purpose of equipping, modifying, and delivering such motor vehicles", I would add, after "vehicles", line 15, page 2, add, "or testing after shop repair work". That's all. Again, a single plate for that purpose, the same purpose.

SPEAKER BAACK: Is there any discussion on this motion to return by Senator Nelson? Seeing none, Senator Nelson, you wish to close?

SENATOR NELSON: Just that simple, they need...they have the same problem, the same concern, and they're not able to take these vehicles out and test them properly. I could have even put a limit on it, a couple miles, but sometimes it takes a little more than that. And that's simply what it is, they need this same thing.

SPEAKER BAACK: We will now proceed to vote on returning the bill to Select File for a specific amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return.
