SPEAKER BAACK: The bill is returned. We will now go to the amendment as offered by Senator Nelson. Senator Nelson, on the amendment.

SENATOR NELSON: Right. Senator Kristensen, now if it was ..when you asked me about a used car dealer, or a normal car dealer, they could stick a dealer's plate on it,...

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Right.

SENATOR NELSON: ...and it would be no problem.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Right.

SENATOR NELSON: My problem is shops that do not sell cars and do not have use of a dealer's plate, that's where the problem is coming in at.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Okay, now, so I get that right, I bring my car in, I already have a plate and my car is registered and licensed. Right? So it wouldn't affect the lion's share of the people who drive in and out of there, because they already have vehicles licensed and titled. Right?
