

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Withem. Any further discussion? Senator Nelson, do you wish to close?

SENATOR NELSON: I have the answer. Dealers bring their cars into them, and the dealers have a number of cars. The dealers only have so many plates, and so they want to keep their plates, for example, Hamilton Chevrolet, I'll just use as an example, they only have so many dealers plates and the salesmen, so when they leave the cars there for them to work on them the dealers take their plates back. And so therefore they are without plates. And that's where the problem is coming in at. In other words, the dealer brings the car to them, leaves the car there for it to be worked on and checked out, the dealer takes his plate back again because he only has so many plates. So, in essence, they are left there without any type plate at all to test the cars. With that, I hope you can support the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard Senator Nelson's closing. We will now proceed to vote on the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 5 ayes, 15 nays on the adoption of the Select File amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is not adopted. Senator Will, do you wish to move to readvance the bill.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. Speaker, I move the readvancement of LB 333 to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to readvance. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is readvanced. Yes, we will now go back, Senator Warner, who had amendments pending on the first two bills, is back, so we'll go back to LB 240 and LB 648. LB 240, first.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator, I have a note that the amendments you had printed in the Journal you want to withdraw. Mr. President, Senator Warner would move to return LB 240 to Select File for specific amendment. (Warner amendment appears on page 1491 of the Legislative Journal.)
