They are 31 students and their teachers from the Douglas Community School in Douglas, Nebraska. Would you folks please stand and be welcomed by the Legislature. Thank you for being with us. We'll now proceed to LB 358.

CLERK: (Read LB 358 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 358 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 1494-95 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 43 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 358 passes. We'll now go to LB 367 with the emergency clause.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 367 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 367, with the emergency clause attached, pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.
