CLERK: (Read record vote as found on pages 1500-01 of the Legislative Journal.) 40 ayes, 0 nays, 4 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 500, with the emergency clause attached, passes. We'll now go to LB 534.
