All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1503 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 42 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 689 passes. We'll go to LB 716E.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 716 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 716, with the emergency clause attached, pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1504 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 43 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 716, with the emergency clause attached, passes. Go to LB 745.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 745 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 745 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1505 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 37 ayes, 2 nays, 5 present and not voting, 5 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 745 passes. We'll now go to LB 766.

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 766 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.
