

down at some point, they are working there. So she is correct on one hand where only two cities have gone through Nebraska. She is incorrect on the other hand that only two cities are trying to get the flight service stations in there. I know of the other interests, North Platte, particularly, and if my memory serves me correctly, Grand Island is also interested in reviving those areas. And, again, it will only be given to an area where the weather, where the FAA believes that the weather and the number of flights is a possible danger to aviation. There are more flights in and out of places such as Grand Island and North Platte; the weather is shown to be in the McCook area and North Platte area to be of tremendous volatility at times in the spring and autumn, particularly because of the river right at the airport there, and I think we are just...we are narrowing ourselves a little bit much in a resolution that we don't need to. Let's let the FAA make its decision, let's let it make it on the criteria of plane boardings, number of people that could be harmed by the number of on and off plane boardings, and the types of weathers involved. The amendment, if it is agreed to, would do everything Senator Hillman wants. It simply says in central and western Nebraska. Why not eastern Nebraska? The flight service station is very, very accurate. They also have a National Weather in Lincoln and Omaha, which there is no problem in communications and the weather update on the eastern part. And I thank the body, and I apologize for taking so much time of the body on a resolution.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Bernard-Stevens. We will now vote on the amendment as offered by Senator Bernard-Stevens. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.
