I think there is a life there, and I think we need to protect that life as well as the life of the mother, the life of the young man, whomever might be involved, all the lives. And so I think when we talk about this, I hope we can all agree that life is what we are talking about aside from what the young woman might want to do, or the parents, or whomever is involved. So, thank you very much. I will continue to listen, probably speak again.
