SPEAKER BAACK: We are looking for Senators Robak, Haberman, and Rod Johnson. Call in votes have been authorized.

CLERK: Senator Schmit voting yes. Senator Rod Johnson voting yes. Senator Ashford voting yes. Senator Conway voting yes.

SPEAKER BAACK: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 7 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.
