SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Okay, and then it goes over to 1556. Maybe if I...to make sure I'm correct, the Legislature recognizes and hereby declares that many teenage pregnancies, and I think what Senator Labeledz wants to do then is change that word "many" to "some". Would that be...is that also part of the amendment?

CLERK: I believe so, yes, sir.

SENATOR BERNARD-STEVENS: Okay. Members of the body, I have no problem with the amendment. I do have to smile a little bit when we...when we get technical on many to some because I think there are a lot of people in Nebraska and some in this body but a lot of people in Nebraska who are simply, do not want to admit, do not want to come publicly and say that many teenage pregnancies are direct or indirect result of family or foster family abuse and neglect, sexual assault. We don't want to say "many", we want to couch it and say there might be some. We will recognize that there could be some but we're certainly not going to be forthright and say "many". And it would be curious if I were really wound up, I would go and ask Senator Labeledz and say, how many would you define as "many" and how many would there be "some" and what's the difference, that's not the point. The point I'm simply trying to make is there are many cases and we need to recognize that fact if we...I'm not going to quibble if we want to ignore that and simply say "some", fine. And I certainly have no objection to the movement of the Lynch amendment to Section 8. Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Bernard-Stevens. Further discussion? Seeing none, Senator Labeledz, do you wish to close?

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I move the amendment.
