SENATOR KRISTENSEN: And to get to the level that you may want to go to.

SENATOR HALL: Right, right.

SENATOR KRISTENSEN: Thank you.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. We'll now go to Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. Speaker, I'd call the question.

SPEAKER BAACK: Do I see five hands? I do. We will now proceed to vote on ceasing debate. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on ceasing debate. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Debate has ceased. Senator Hall, to close on the committee amendments.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. Speaker, I would just move adoption of the committee amendments. The concept has, I think, been discussed and was discussed much prior to the bill reaching the floor. The fact that there was little or no objection to the committee amendments, I think, shows that folks probably understand this as best they can prior to seeing it in operation. And I'm of the mind that that is going to happen shortly. With that, I would move adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard Senator Hall's closing. We will now proceed to vote on the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the committee amendments.
