There comes a time when you can't go back to the people again and again and again and say, well, blame the court. We don't need to blame the court for the mess we're in. The blame belongs on the floor of this Legislature. Oh yeah, the court helps a little, but we invite them, we invite them to get into the mess. The first thing you want to do when you draft a bill, and that's another advantage I have to not being a lawyer, not so that it can be understood, draft it so it cannot be misunderstood. This can't even be understood. Senator Moore, my good friend, I'll give you all the time you want of my remaining time to tell me how you're going to calculate the value on your farm or my farm based upon this amendment. My time is your time.

SENATOR MOORE: Oh, I'll pass.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Senator Rod Johnson. Senator anyone. Senator Wehrbein, you take the time.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: (Inaudible).

SENATOR SCHMIT: I've made my point again, Mr. President. The point is this. No one can do it. There isn't an actuary in this Capitol, there isn't an accountant in this Capitol who can do it.

SPEAKER BAACK: One minute.
