

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. As I mentioned, this was a technical amendment brought to us by Todd Sneller with the Ethanol Authority or the Gasohol Committee. It simply adds the words weighted oxygen or "weight oxygen" after .1 cent, .1 percent. That's just technically a more correct way to present the amendment. I should have probably had the whole amendment redrafted, but I decided since it was coming up quickly on the agenda just to offer the amendment to the amendment and, as I said, it's simply a technical term that would make the amendment more acceptable by Mr. Sneller's standards. So I would move the amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Is there discussion of the Rod Johnson amendment to the Rod Johnson amendment? Senator Schmit, did you wish to discuss that? Senator Schrock, did you wish to discuss that? Senator Rod Johnson, do you wish to close? We will now vote on the amendment to the amendment offered by Senator Rod Johnson. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Johnson's amendment to his amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment to the amendment is adopted. Now we're back to the amendment as amended. Senator Smith, did you wish to discuss the amendment as amended? Senator Schrock, did you wish to discuss this? Anyone else wishing to discuss the Rod Johnson amendment as amended? Seeing none, Senator Rod Johnson, do you wish to close? We will now proceed to vote on the amendment offered by Senator Rod Johnson. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the amendment by Rod Johnson. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Johnson's amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Johnson's amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: We will now proceed to advancement. Is there any discussion on the advancement of LB 754? Senator Smith. She waives off. Any discussion? Senator Schrock.
