CLERK: 26 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 732A.

SPEAKER BAACK: LB 732A advances. Items for the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, Committee on Natural Resources gives notice of confirmation hearing. Enrollment and Review reports LB 320 to Select File, and LB 754 to Select File. Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to place LB 327 on General File pursuant to Rule 3, Section 19. That will be laid over. Confirmation report from Health and Human Services Committee, signed by Senator Wesely; and an explanation of vote from Senator Smith. That's all that I have, Mr. President. SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We'll now go to LB 409.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first item on LB 409 are Enrollment and Review amendments.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. Speaker, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 409.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first amendment to the bill is by Senator Withem. Senator, this is AM896. It was my understanding you wanted to withdraw this one, Senator, and substitute.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: Yes, I would.

CLERK: Senator, substitute AM1058, is that correct? (Withem amendment appears on page 1638 of the Legislative Journal.)
