

way of working this out and that is to say that any subcontractor that is working under a licensed certified installation or removal contractor need not be licensed, him or herself. We have the amendment drafted. I was under the impression that it was coming down immediately from the Bill Drafter's Office, but it is not here in our possession yet. So I think what I...Mr. Speaker, I am in a dilemma here. I have got an idea that I want to run but we don't have the language here physically present down from Bill Drafter's Office yet. I could either temporarily pass over this amendment and have it brought back up when the amendment to the amendment comes down from the Bill Drafter's Office, would that be okay?

SPEAKER BAACK: That would be perfectly fine, Senator Withem. We do have other amendments to the bill. We can take up some of those.

SENATOR WITHEM: Okay, fine let's do that.

SPEAKER BAACK: It is passed over. Next item on the bill, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Beutler has the next two amendments. Senator, I had notes on these that you wanted to withdraw these two.

SPEAKER BAACK: They are withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have to the bill is by Senator Schmit. Senator, this is your amendment that we printed on page 1341 of the Journal.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Schmit.

CLERK: Senator Schmit I think wants to withdraw, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: The next amendment, Mr. President, is by Senators Robak and Schmit. Senator, I have AM1168 in front of me. (See pages 1639-49 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Schmit.
