SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the closing on the adoption of the Rod Johnson amendment. All those in...we will now proceed to vote. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. We are voting on the amendment by Senator Rod Johnson. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Johnson's amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Johnson's amendment is adopted. Anything further on the bill?

CLERK: Nothing further, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Is there a motion to advance the bill? Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: I would move we advance LB 663.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to advance LB 663. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. LB 663A. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, 663A, I have an amendment to the bill by Senator Withem.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: Which amendment is that, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Well, Senator, I've got two, as you know, AM990 and AM1188.

SENATOR WITHEM: Whichever one, that's fine.

CLERK: I prefer 1188, if that's all right with you, Senator.

SENATOR WITHEM: LB 1188 will be great then, in that case.
