What's going on here is that somehow we filed two identical amendments, both of them adding the emergency clause, and I don't know how we did that but I don't know if you adopt both of them, that means it takes effect before it's passed or if one cancels out the other or what happens. But what this amendment does is it very simply adds the emergency clause to the emergency...to the appropriations bill. We had already added the emergency clause to the bill itself and so this will make the appropriations take effect immediately upon passage.

SPEAKER BAACK: Any discussion on the amendment offered by Senator Withem? Seeing none, do you wish to close, Senator Withem? Waives closing. We will now proceed to vote on the amendment by Senator Withem. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Withem's amendment.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Will, do you wish to move the bill?

SENATOR WILL: I move the advancement of LB 663A to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to advance LB 663A. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. LB 123, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LB 123, Senator, I have E & R amendments.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Mr. Speaker, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 123.

SPEAKER BAACK: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. They are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Senator.
