

shifting of the coalition of senators occurs in the body. But I think this is a very good bill, and I think it's most reasonable how any woman whose gone through the trauma of a sexual attack deserves the opportunity to know when that person is being releases for any reason. And unfortunately there is a fairly high rate of repeat activity in those kind of offenders. And I think that makes it especially important that that person have the opportunity to know if that person is out, if they so desire. And as Senator Lindsay said, it gives them an opportunity to alter what they're doing and how they're living, if they so choose. And I would urge the body to support this bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Rasmussen. Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL: Thank you, Madam President, members of the body. I, too, rise to add my name to the list of people who disagree with Senator Lindsay sometimes but agree with him now. This is a notification bill that I wholeheartedly support. I think there is no question that we too often ignore the victims of crimes, we don't address their concerns through legislation. I applaud Senator Lindsay's efforts. I am a co-sponsor of this bill, and I urge your vote to advance it. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Will. Does anyone else wish to address the bill? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Lindsay?

SENATOR LINDSAY: Yes, Madam Speaker and members. I didn't realize this was a notification bill, I think I probably ought to withdraw it. (Laughter.) But, no, I think it's been...in light of the fact there's been no opposition statements so far, I think I'll just shut up and ask that the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Lindsay. We'll now vote on the motion to advance LB 186. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of 186.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 186 is advanced. LB 186A.
