PRESIDENT MOUL PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MOUL: Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain this morning is from Senator Dan Lynch's District in Omaha, Pastor James Hardy from Florence Christian Church. Pastor Hardy.

PASTOR JAMES HARDY: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Pastor Hardy. I now call to order the Sixty-Second day in the Ninety-Second Legislature, First Session. We will proceed with roll call. Please record your presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Are there any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Are there any messages, reports or announcements?

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Wickersham would like to print amendments to LB 715. (See pages 1679-80 of the Legislative Journal.

A new resolution, LR 70, by Senator Robinson. (Read brief description. See page 1680 of the Legislative Journal.) That will be laid over. That's all that I have, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. While the Legislature is in session and capable of conducting business, I propose to sign and do sign LR 69. We will proceed with General File, special order. And, for the moment, we will pass over LB 825 and go to LB 852.

CLERK: Mr. President, 852 was a bill introduced by the Speaker at the request of the Governor. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on March 12, referred to the Government Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments pending by the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee, Madam President.
