

different than we treat people who drive a train or who are over the road commercial truck drivers or a number of other professionals who could, in fact, endanger the lives of people on the roads or wherever else it might be. The amendments will simply provide for that. It's in...I just can't believe a nurse would take a drug away from an infant who is receiving that to help that poor little soul's pain and get away with it. I don't think they should. They ought to be in jail and we ought to have amendments in these bills to make sure that we understand the difference between those kinds of inhumane and criminal activity than someone who is just sick and needs rehabilitation, and that's probably what we will try to accomplish. I won't have them ready for you. I just...we talked about putting them together this morning, but we will have them in time for Select File, and I'll be certainly glad to go over them with Don to make sure he understands why we think it's important that we do it.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Lynch. Senator Beutler, do you wish to speak on the amendment?

SENATOR BEUTLER: I just had a quick question for Senator Wesely if I may. On your amendment, Senator Wesely, you indicated you were taking another bill and putting it into this bill and there were a set of committee amendments that pertained to LB 387. Could you just talk a little bit about whether those are incorporated in your amendment or some of them are, some of them aren't, and what Standing Committee thoughts were left out of your amendment, I guess, just purposes of perspective.

SENATOR WESELY: Senator Beutler, we have completely incorporated all the committee amendments into this amendment. We have not made any changes from the bill as amended by committee. And...should I follow up because actually it's a good question that I'm glad to have the chance to respond to. If you look at the statement on LB 387, you will see there are a number of changes the committee made to the bill. This is because at the hearing we did have some concerns expressed by some individuals in law enforcement and otherwise about the release of information, confidentiality of information, and we worked out through negotiation with the different parties the amendments that the committee adopted to the bill which have brought, I think, the various interests all together in support of the legislation. So as we drafted this amendment to 456, we incorporated all those amendments because they are, in fact,
