

April 18, 1991 LB 456, 456A

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Wesely. We will now vote on the motion to advance LB 456. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of 456.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 456 is advanced. I would like to direct the senators' attention to the south balcony where Senator Wehrbein has 12 guests from the Four Corners Extension Club in Syracuse, Nebraska. Would you rise and be welcomed to the legislative Chambers this morning. Thank you. And also in the north balcony are guests of Senator Bernard-Stevens. There are 90 sixth, seventh and eighth grade students who are all part of the Gifted Student Program at North Platte and their teacher. Would you please rise and be recognized and welcome to the Chamber. Thank you. We will now go to General File, LB 456A.

CLERK: Madam President, LB 456A was a bill introduced by Senator Wesely. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Wesely.

SENATOR WESELY: I move to advance the bill. It just funds the last bill. It's all a cash fund, there is no General Fund. It's all...456A, the assistance program, is funded through the \$1.00 per license fee addition that all health professionals will pay and there will also be perhaps, I'm thinking of some fees that is possibly assessed to the employees involved, but this is a \$1.00 assessment that is a cash fund generated and I'd move for advancement of the A bill.
