PRESIDENT MOUL: Does anyone else wish to speak? Seeing none, we will vote on the motion to advance the bill. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance 503, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 503 is advanced. LB 503A.

CLERK: 503A, introduced by Senator Moore. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Moore.

SENATOR MOORE: I'd simply move the bill be advanced and recognize that it's Cash Funds, no General Funds.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Moore. Is there anyone who wishes to speak to this motion? Seeing none, we will vote on the motion to advance LB 503A. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 503A is advanced. Speaker Baack.

SPEAKER BAACK: Yes, Madam President and colleagues, before I move us to recess, I would like to announce there will be a change in the agenda. LB 409, that we bracketed yesterday, is now ready and we are under some time constraints, so we do need to get that bill moving today. So that bill will be first up at one-thirty, when we come back. We will be bringing that bill back, we'll be discussing 409 when we come back. And then we will go to Senator Elmer's motion to pull LR 27 out of committee. With that, I move that we recess till one-thirty.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Speaker Baack. Are there items for the record?
