

SENATOR DIERKS: I would accept call in votes.

SPEAKER BAACK: Call in votes have been authorized. I might remind members that we are voting on the amendment to the committee amendments by Senator Dierks.

CLERK: Senator Wickersham voting yes. Senator Lindsay voting no. Senator Abboud voting yes. Senator Warner voting no. Senator Will voting no. Senator Coordsen voting yes. Senator Rasmussen voting yes. Senator Rogers voting yes.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Rod Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: A roll call please.

SPEAKER BAACK: We have a request for a roll call vote. Senator Kristensen, would you record your presence, please. Senator Schrock, would you check in, please. Senator Schimek, check in, please. The house is under call. All members please report to the Chamber and record your presence. Roll call in reverse order has been requested. Looking for Senators Wesely and Byars, and Senators Ashford and Moore. Senator Wesely, please record your presence. We are now looking for Senator Moore. Senator Rod Johnson, do you wish to proceed?

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Yes.

SPEAKER BAACK: Okay, we will go ahead and call the roll in reverse order.
