

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Wickersham would move to amend committee amendments. Senator, I have AM1320 in front of me. (See page 1737 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: Senator Wickersham.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Thank you, Madam President. Members of the body, I apolo...there will be a series of amendments here, and I apologize to you for bringing them one at a time, but they are rather technical in nature, and I think if we are able to go through them one at a time, it will be a little bit clearer about what we are doing. The current amendment, AM1320, I think you have on your desk. It is marked as number two. It simply adds one more category to the list of activities that can be supported, and in this case, we are adding "transport" to the list that is already there, the conduct of research and development, the processing, and storage, or sale of goods, commodities, et cetera. So it is simply one more activity that may be supported through this funding mechanism. We are simply adding the word "transport", so you would have transportation activities that could be supported. With that, I'd move adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. Is there anyone who wishes to debate this amendment? Seeing none, we will vote on this Senator Wickersham amendment to the amendments please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.
