

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: So they would have to teach and so forth. Okay, another question I have, I know there is...I'm sure, I'm not sure, but I'm fairly sure that there are some schools that have under 200 students that probably have a full-time administrator, we call them superintendents. Then I know there are...they may have a teaching principal that may teach half-time and then he's an administrator half-time and you may even have someone that's with all the activities that we have, that may be an activities director which is an administrative position. How would that, for a school under that, for example, if you had say, let's say there is 210 in the school, you have a full-time administrator. Okay, does that mean that if there is a principal to teach and it teaches 30 percent of the time that he would have to teach a full load then? Or under your amendment would they be allowed to have that 70 percent of administration in there also?

SENATOR LYNCH: What the legislation does, Senator, is strictly defined superintendent responsibilities or administrator responsibilities and how many students should probably define, again, the need for a full-time administrator. If you had more than 200 students the possibility exists that you would still only need one full-time administrator, but for example, there are a school district or two that have more than 200 students that's still defined as part-time the administrator responsibilities. One, for example, is the Chambers public school which has right at 200 students and they define their administrator or their superintendent as being a .75 full-time equivalent administrator.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Yeah.

SENATOR ROBINSON: And so you can do this now, but there are a number, a number of systems with less than 200 students that still have not only one full-time administrator, but in some cases 2.5 percent administrators, for example.

SENATOR ROBINSON: Let me phrase the question, Senator Lynch, let me phrase the question a little differently. If you...do you add the part-time administrators, are those added into that one full-time administrator?

SENATOR LYNCH: Yes.

SENATOR ROBINSON: All right, so if...let's say you have
