SENATOR HALL: ...but I'll bring it back next year, and I think I'll be able to justify my point with regard to the amount of the license that we're talking about in this amendment. I respectfully withdraw the amendment, Mr. Clerk.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment is withdrawn.
