CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Smith's amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted. Senator Will, would you like to make a motion?

SENATOR WILL: Madam President, I move the readvancement of LB 57 to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: You have heard the motion to advance LB 57. All those in favor please say aye. Opposed nay. We will proceed with Final Reading now. Would you please return to your seats. While we are waiting, I would like to direct the senators' attention to the south balcony, special guests today of Senator Warner are 26 third graders from Westfall Elementary in Malcolm, Nebraska. Would you please rise and be recognized. Welcome to the Chambers. Also seated under the north balcony is a special guest of Senator Cudaback. She is Sherry Morrow from Kearney State College. Sherry, would you please rise and be recognized. Thank you. Senators are all seated, we will proceed with Final Reading on LB 333E.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 333 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MOUL: All provisions of the law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 333 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read. See pages 1774-75 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 42 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting, Madam President.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 333 is passed. Proceed with Item 9 on the agenda, General File, LB 720.

CLERK: Madam President, LB 720 was a bill introduced by Senators Horgan, Labeledz, Rasmussen, Lynch, Wickersham, Will, Chizek, Robinson. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 23, referred to the Government Committee for public hearing. The bill was advanced to General File.
