LB 333, 720, 798

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Conway. Does anyone else wish to debate the Smith amendment? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Smith? Closing is waived. We will vote on the Smith amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on adoption of Senator Smith's amendment.

PRESIDENT MOUL: The amendment is adopted. Is there anyone...

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Madam President, excuse me.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Is there anyone else who would like to speak to the bill, itself? Seeing none, would you close, Senator Conway?

SENATOR CONWAY: Thank you, Madam President. The bill now, as we have discussed, is simply the identification of August 2nd as the official date for the Persian Gulf War, and for anyone who has served from August 2nd until the President makes a declaration or the law is determined, determining what the ending date is, right now it is still open, and anyone serving during that period of time who returns back to the State of Nebraska will be recognized as a veteran of the Persian Gulf War. And with Senator Smith's attachment of the E clause, this will go into effect upon the signing of the Governor. So I urge the body to support it.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Conway. We will now vote on the motion to advance LB 720. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the advancement of 720.

PRESIDENT MOUL: LB 720 is advanced. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LB 333. We will now proceed with Select File, LB 798.

CLERK: LB 798, Madam President, the first item I have are Enrollment and Review amendments.
