auditing department. That department has some of the duties such as special investigations, auditing phone and expense, phone and expense accounts, auditing of community grants, et cetera. There is no specific statutory authority for that delegation of authority to the clerk's office. This would create that authority. It would also increase the salary provision of the county comptroller which hasn't been changed in statute since 1929. I would ask that the amendment be adopted. I also thank Senator Johnson for allowing this amendment to be put up on his bill.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Lindsay. Does anyone else wish to speak to this amendment? Seeing none, we will vote on the Lindsay amendment. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President.
