

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But this amendment would probably work on LB 569 just as well.

SENATOR CROSBY: (Laughter.) You want to stick it in on everything, all right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But you're listening.

SENATOR CROSBY: All right, I'm on page 6...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, and see, Senator Crosby, the way the language of the bill reads now, if you read it, it's just a broad statement. Excuse me a minute. I was given...

SENATOR CROSBY: I don't...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: All right, look...look in line 5, on page 6, it says, cooperate with the political parties of the state and take such action as may be necessary to give effect to their directions, including assistance with the selection of delegates, and so forth.

SENATOR CROSBY: That's not on my page 6, unless I'm looking at the wrong...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, anyway, let me read this to you and tell you what is being stricken.

SENATOR CROSBY: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: There is the statement in the bill that says that this director will cooperate with the political parties of the state and take such action as may be necessary to give effect to their directions. The language stricken is "give effect to their directions", because that language would mean whatever they're being directed to do. You might have a Republican version. (Laugh.) I see that demagog back there trying to help you, named Senator Withem.

SENATOR CROSBY: No, Patrick, everybody is helping. Thank you. I was looking...I was looking at the wrong amendment, evidently. Okay, I'm with you now.
