SPEAKER BAACK:    Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL:     Mr. Speaker, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 773.

SPEAKER BAACK:    You have heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 773. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. They are adopted.

CLERK:    Mr. President, the first amendment to the bill is by Senator Hall. Senator...

SPEAKER BAACK:    Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL:     Yeah, Senator Hall is not here today and asked that I ask that this amendment be passed over.

SPEAKER BAACK:    It is passed over.

CLERK:    The second amendment from Senator Hall.

SPEAKER BAACK:    Senator Will.

SENATOR WILL:     Same thing, please.

SPEAKER BAACK:    It is passed over.

CLERK:    Senator Hartnett would move to amend the bill, Mr. President. (See AM1293 on page 1724 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK:    Senator Hartnett.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Which amendment is it?

CLERK:    AM1293.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Mr. Speaker and members of the body, all three of these amendments were brought to me by the Department of Revenue, and what this does is simply changes the date from January 1, 1990 to effective date of October 1, 1991, and that is all it does. The Department of Revenue wanted...it seemed to fit better with the bill and with what the section does, and so with that I would just simply ask that this amendment be adopted. Change of date is all.
