

half will go into the Highway Patrol, into their drug enforcement funds and the educational funds that they have. So it is simply a redistribution of those funds as they are collected. There is also 5 percent that will be retained by the Department of Revenue for their administrative costs that go with it. So, basically, all we are doing is redistributing these funds and splitting them with the county, instead of them all going in, and we are not going to lose any funds under this because, in many cases, the county attorneys aren't filing right now because there is nothing in it for them. So we create an incentive for them to go ahead and make those filings. I believe, Mr. Clerk, there is a technical amendment to that amendment as well.

SENATOR CONWAY: The amendment, after I introduced this, was brought to me by the Revenue Department and, basically, what it does, it clarifies that if the proceeds of the tax did not originate in a specific county, e.g., the purchase of the stamps, then the proceeds would be distributed, 5 percent to the Marijuana and Controlled Substances Tax and Administration Fund, and the remaining proceeds would then go to the Nebraska State Patrol. It is a clarification for situations where the situs specific isn't all that clear, and so they have a technical amendment that simply says that all remaining funds, including that which did not originate in the county, shall be credited to the Nebraska State Patrol Drug Control and Education Cash Fund. And so it is a clarification amendment that they wanted attached to the amendment that I offered.
