SPEAKER BAACK: The bill does not advance. We will now proceed to the next bill, LB 795. The call is raised. But I would encourage my colleagues to stay close at hand so we can get some business done this afternoon because we will be adjourning early today for Former Legislators Day.

CLERK: Mr. President, 795, E & R amendments were considered and adopted yesterday. At that time Senator Conway made a motion to indefinitely postpone the bill. That motion is now pending.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, the kill motion was put up by Senator Conway because I was not going to be here yesterday. I was out of the state. I intended to be anyway. It's my understanding he is downstairs conducting an interview and would withdraw the motion were he here. We'd like to take the bill up and roll over the kill motion for the moment till he gets here, that would be fine with me. Or if you want to just roll over 795 and continue down the calendar, I have no problem with that either. It's...

SPEAKER BAACK: We'll go ahead and take up the bill. First item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the E & R amendments were considered and adopted yesterday. I now have pending an amendment by Senator Hall. Senator, AM1448. (sic) (Journal shows AM1468.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members, this amendment has been passed out to you just in the last 10 minutes and it does two things. It strikes the original sections of the bill and all amendments thereto. I wanted to state for the record that it was not my intention to strike the original sections and leave any amendments, but for purposes of this amendment it would strike the original sections of the bill and the amendments. It would do the following. It would ban, to the best of my understanding, hopefully, it would ban video keno machines. Currently the State of Nebraska is conducting an experiment with video keno machines in local lotteries and they have been in place now I think a little over a month, about six
