SPEAKER BAACK: Any discussion on the amendment to suspend the rules? Motion. Seeing none, we will proceed to vote on the motion to suspend the rules to permit Final Reading. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

SPEAKER BAACK: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 409 with the emergency clause attached pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.
