SPEAKER BAACK: One minute.

SENATOR SCHMIT: ...it probably will be less than that when you downsize it by the court, et cetera. But more important is this, more important is this, and I understand the realities of the budget process, but, ladies and gentlemen, we ought to pay our old obligations first before we take on new ones. I'm willing to take my share of those cuts. I think that every one of us in here will. If we can't pay up our old debts, we should not be acquiring additional ones. The obligations of the past ought to take precedence over the wants and even the needs of the future. We have one more chance, ladies and gentlemen, to do that during this session of the Legislature. We ought not to let the time go by, we ought not to tell the Commonwealth depositors we're going to do something in the future. We have promised them too many times and as Senator Coordsen has said, too many times they have been found wanting. I would hope that you will support the amendment...

SPEAKER BAACK: Time.
