CLERK: (Read roll call vote. See page 1841 of the Legislative Journal.) 23 ayes, 25 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: The amendment fails, the first half of the amendment fails. We are now on the second half of the amendment. Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I would defer action on the second half at this time in view of conserving the Legislature's time and I want to thank those who did give the support to the proposal and I'm sure it will come up again.

SPEAKER BAACK: The second half of the amendment is withdrawn. The next item on LB 850, Mr. Clerk. The call is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next motion I have is a motion by Senator Lindsay. Senator Lindsay would move to reconsider the vote on the Morrissey amendment. (Amendment appears on page 1510 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Lindsay.

SENATOR LINDSAY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members, I filed this motion to reconsider after talking with Senator Morrissey about his amendment to this bill. If you recall, the amendment would allow for payments under in the Low-Level Nuclear Waste Cash Fund. Basically what it came down to, even though we repeated it I guess hundreds of times, it was my understanding this was a General Fund appropriation rather than a Cash Fund appropriation and to me that made a difference. For that reason I filed the motion to reconsider. I would urge that the motion be allowed and that the amendment be adopted.

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Lindsay. Senator Morrissey, on the motion to reconsider.

SENATOR MORRISSEY: Thank you, Senator Lindsay, members, I just...in talking to Senator Lindsay, I don't want to drag this on, folks. I just wanted to make sure everyone had a clear idea. I did say it a number of times, the money will come from a Low-Level Cash Fund, number 4840, that is provided for circumstances that address the siting of the low-level facility.
