

having an open court room and the arrival of a jury, \$8,000 per case. I had a chance to review the expenditures in other states where there are mediation centers. One of them in Oklahoma had broken out the 6,000 cases that they'd settled in the previous year, or handled. Of those, 90 percent reached conclusion, and the fixed cost per case was \$67. I urge the adoption of the amendment and then the advancement of the bill.
