

SPEAKER BAACK: Thank you, Senator Hillman. Senator Haberman, did you wish to discuss the motion further?

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. President, members of the body, I have a couple of questions I would like to ask Senator Warner, if he'd yield, please.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Warner, would you please respond.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Senator Warner, you mentioned that there would be some other contributions that would trigger in, and they had to have these contributions, as I understand it, before the \$100,000, or whatever, triggers in. Is this correct? The private contributions have to be added to this before we spend the state tax dollars.

SENATOR WARNER: Not that I'm aware of.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Well, then what did you say, what did you mean when you said that...

SENATOR WARNER: I was...

SENATOR HABERMAN: ...other contributions will trigger in? I mean, what's the...

SENATOR WARNER: I was merely indicating that the General Fund portion of the appropriation in 714 is eliminated, that there would still remain the appropriation of what would be Cash Funds. And LB 714, in the body itself, authorizes gifts, bequests, other contributions to be made to this Trail Development Assistance Fund, and what would remain in the bill would be the authorization of that appropriation of Cash Funds, gifts, bequests, so forth, to be expended.

SENATOR HABERMAN: So the...so I misunderstood what you said then. There is nothing to...

SENATOR WARNER: There's no match.

SENATOR HABERMAN: ...the bill triggering in, or working, if there are private contributions. So that has nothing to do with the General Fund money, is that correct?

SENATOR WARNER: No, General Fund money could either be there or
