SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I'd like to have a call of the house, please, and I guess we just as well have a roll call vote and move forward from there.

SPEAKER BAACK: A request for a call of the house. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: The motion fails. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose and do sign LB 742, LB 583, LB 528, and LB 123. Next item on the bill, Mr. Clerk. The call is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler would move to amend the bill.

SPEAKER BAACK: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Clerk, I'd like to withdraw that amendment temporarily.

SPEAKER BAACK: It is withdrawn.
