

General Fund to Cash Funds that we use. We're significantly lower, as I recall, than many others areas in relative use of Cash Funds for recreation, as opposed to general tax support. But, with that, I think this removes the immediate issue of competition with others by using General Fund money for the acquisition, and to that extent would be an improvement. Still will authorize the expenditure of Cash Funds that, is gifts or bequests that they would acquire and that, of course, they can do in any event. But it does retain the authorization of the expenditure if those dollars materialize. So I'd move adoption if the amendment.
