SPEAKER BAACK: Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Roll call.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BAACK: Do you have items for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, Enrollment and Review reports LB 456 and LB 456A to Select File. Those are signed by Senator Will as Enrollment and Review Chair. (See pages 1877-88 of the Legislative Journal.) That is all that I have.

SPEAKER BAACK: We will proceed now to General File and LB 827.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 827 is a bill originally introduced by Senators Rod Johnson, Morrissey, and Schmit. (Read title.) The bill was introduced in January, referred to Natural Resources, advanced to General File. The bill was discussed on April 18, at which time the committee amendments were adopted. An amendment to the bill by Senator Johnson was adopted, as well as an amendment by Senator Dierks, and Senator Johnson. Have pending, Mr. President, the first amendment offered by Senator Morrissey. Senator Morrissey's amendment is on page 1727 of the Legislative Journal. (See AM1334.)
