SENATOR WESELY: Yes, that's who it's...

SENATOR PIRSCH: Okay, and then we talk about a mandate that the parents must be notified if a child has a contagious disease. How does that work? Obviously if a child comes down with a contagious disease, the parents must keep them home. Is that not correct?

SENATOR WESELY: That's right.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Okay, and then when the facility is informed about that then they must notify all the other parents that have had contact with that child?

SENATOR WESELY: That's right.

SENATOR PIRSCH: I think that's a good provision.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Now is that in the unlicensed as well as the licensed, or the voluntary...

SENATOR WESELY: No, the voluntary we haven't clarified what they have to do or don't have to do, but in the licensed this would apply.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Okay. And the sanction to that of course would be loss of a license.

SENATOR WESELY: Right.

SENATOR PIRSCH: To any of these actually.

SENATOR WESELY: Yeah, that's really the (inaudible).

SENATOR PIRSCH: And then we talk about the department inspecting the day care homes. These also would be the homes between the four and eight.

SENATOR WESELY: Right.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Okay. And more than eight we already have the Department of Social Services does not inspect them.
