PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Morrissey. Mr. Clerk, do we have an amendment on the desk yet?

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Beutler would move to amend the committee amendments. Senator, this is the amendment, page 1, lines 7 to 14, strike six months and insert five years.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Clerk, I will pull the amendment for now.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Does anyone else wish to speak to the committee amendments? Seeing none, do you have closing, Senator Chizek?

SENATOR CHIZEK: Just to apologize to Senator Baack. I was out of the Chamber when the committee amendments came up but it's somewhat complicated. I remember the discussion when the committee dealt with the committee amendment and I think if Senator Morrissey has some questions on Select why we can...we can deal with him there. But I would just ask your support in adoption of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MOUL: Thank you, Senator Chizek. We will now vote on the motion to adopt the committee amendments to LB 413. All those in favor please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted on the committee amendments? Have you all voted? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of the committee amendments.
